

How to get to the conference site for IICIS 2002

The conference takes place at Gustav-Stresemann-Institut (GSI). It is near the recreation area "Rheinaue" in the quarter where the federal government resided before partly moving to Berlin. Hence, it is easily accessible by various modes of transportation.

Plane

Cologne/Bonn airport (CGN) is the nearest airport. You can take a taxi to the GSI for approximately 32 €. As an alternative you can take bus 670 to the city centre and then take a tram or a bus to the GSI. The fare for the bus is 4,80 €. You can use the same ticket on the connecting tram/bus.

Frankfurt airport (FRA) offers the most international connections. Take a train to Bonn, then change to tram/bus to GSI. There is a new ICE express railway line between Frankfurt airport and Siegburg/Bonn. Single fare is around 45 €. The more scenic route along the river Rhine takes half an hour longer for a lower price of around 30 €.

Train

There are frequent train connections to and from Bonn. Main station is Bonn Hauptbahnhof in the city centre. The new ICE trains along the Cologne–Frankfurt express railway line stop at Siegburg/Bonn east of Bonn. Many international connections require to change trains in Cologne (e.g. Thalys). An on-line travel planner is provided by the German Railroad Deutsche Bahn at <http://reiseauskunft.bahn.de/bin/query.exe/en>. It provides information on all trains and local transportation in Germany.

Public transport

From Bonn Hauptbahnhof you can take tram 66 direction Königswinter/Bad Honnef to Robert-Schuman-Platz (ca. 10 minutes) or tram 16/63 direction Bad Godesberg to Max-Löbner-Straße/Friesdorf (ca. 10 minutes) and walk five minutes to GSI. An alternative is to take bus 623 direction Robert-Schuman-Platz to Langer Grabenweg right at GSI (ca. 30 minutes and not on Sundays). Fare is 1,90 €.

If you arrive with an ICE train at Siegburg/Bonn you take tram 66 to Robert-Schuman-Platz (ca. 30 minutes) and walk five minutes to GSI. Fare is 4,90 €.

Taxi

Taxis are available in front of the train station and the airport. It is also possible to catch one at various places in the city centre. However, it is unusual to get a taxi right from the street. You can also order a taxi to your location by calling the taxi central at +49 (228) 555555.

Transfer from the city centre to the GSI costs approximately 11 €, from the airport approx. 32 €.

Car

Arriving from west:

Autobahn A61, change to A565 direction Bonn at interchange Meckenheim. Leave A565 at exit Poppelsdorf in direction B9 Bad Godesberg. When you see a building labelled "ADAC" and a BP gas station, turn left into Max-Löbner-Straße. At the end of Max-Löbner-Straße turn left again.

Arriving from north/east/south:

Autobahn A3, change to A560 direction Bonn at interchange Bonn/Siegburg. Change to A59 direction Bonn-Bad Godesberg at interchange St. Augustin. Change to A562 at interchange Bonn-Ost (42). Leave A562 at exit Rheinaue and turn left. At the next traffic light turn right into Heinemannstraße. Turn left at next traffic light.
